## Let's find your ring size.

Print this at $100 \%$. Do not scale to fit.
(To make sure it is printed at $100 \%$, place credit or ID card in the box below. If it's an exact fit, you can use this guide.)
Method 1: Ring Sizer Ruler.

1 Cut the tool below. Carefully cut the line to create a slit.

2 Wrap the ruler around the finger at the base and pull the tapered end through the slit.

3 For an accurate measurement, pull the ruler tight over the widest part of your finger. This could be a knuckle.

4 Read the number that lines up next to the slit. This is your ring size.


Size 7 17.3 mm

Size 9 18.9 mm

Size 10 19.8 mm

Size 11 20.4 mm

Size 12 21.5 mm

## Method 2: Existing Ring.

Place a credit or ID card here to to make sure the tool printed at $100 \%$

Find The ring that you want to mach or compare.
Measure Place the ring on top of each circle until you find a perfect match.

Determine The match should perfectly fit inside on the ring.
